APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, an applicant must satisfy the following minimum requirements:

1. Must be a Laotian college student (freshmen, sophomore, junior, or senior)
2. Must be a Georgia resident
3. Must be currently enrolled in or accepted to an undergraduate degree program at an accredited university, community college or technical college
4. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher for collegiate applicants: high school seniors must have an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Application package must be postmarked no later than July 24, 2010.
2. No application materials will be returned.
3. The LAS Scholarship Committee requires that all information be included within one application package. The original application, personal resume, essays, transcripts, and proof of enrollment must be postmarked by July 24, 2010.
4. Essays and personal resume must be typed.
5. E-mail scholarships@lasga.org a notification once your application has been mailed to LAS.
6. You will be notified via e-mail when the Scholarship Committee has received your application.
7. Scholarship recipients must attend the Educational Award Ceremony on Aug. 14, 2010.
8. Scholarship recipients will receive their scholarship award upon receipt of an official letter from their accredited university, community college, or technical college indicating enrollment for the upcoming academic year.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

To be accepted for judging, an applicant must meet the Eligibility Requirements listed above and submit **ALL REQUIRED MATERIALS IN ONE PACKAGE**. Incomplete applications will be immediately disqualified from judging with no further follow-up. Applications that are postmarked after July 24, 2010 will be immediately disqualified from judging with no further follow-up. Official transcripts must be submitted in individually sealed envelopes in the application package, with the Registrar's/Advisor's signature over the seal.
